

Dr. Tuncer Ören



Dr. Ören is a professor emeritus of computer science at the School of Information Technology and Engineering of the University of Ottawa, Canada. His Ph.D. is in Systems Engineering from the University of Arizona.

His *research interests* include advanced methodologies for modelling and simulation, agent-directed simulation, cognitive simulation, failure avoidance, and ethics in simulation as well as body of knowledge and terminology of simulation.

He has over 400 *publications* including 21 books and proceedings. He contributed to over 370 *conferences* and *seminars* held in 30 countries. In the 2000s alone, over 100 publications and over 40 invited presentations.

Some of the positions he currently holds at SCS (The Society for Modeling and Simulation International) are: member of the Executive Committee, Director-at-large, VP Publications, AVP ethics, AVP student chapters, distinguished lecturer, and founding director of M&SNet.

Awards include "Information Age Award" from the Turkish Ministry of Culture, and Distinguished Service Award from SCS. *Honors and distinctions* include recognition by IBM as a pioneer of computing in Canada, invitations from United Nations, over 20 Who's Who citations, and plaques and certificates of appreciation from organizations including ACM, AFCEA, Atomic Energy of Canada, NATO, SCS, Turkish General Staff, and some universities.
