Teacher Assistanceship

1. Decide the courses from the posting that you wish to TA
2. Fill out a TA application form outside Michèle's office. Please save paper by filling out one application for all the courses you wish to TA
3. Wait for the results. Michèle is uninvolved in the selection process, so don't pester her for updates.
4. If you are successful, respond to the UOHMS offer email, otherwise you lose the position
5. Visit Michèle in person if you have questions
